NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, pursuant to Government Code Sections 61060, 61115, 61115(c), and 61060(h) by the Board of Directors of the District as follows:

The rates set forth in Section 2-2. (Sewer Use Rates) of ORDINANCE 1994-2 are hereby repealed and replaced with the rates as shown on Attachment "A" hereto, which attachment is incorporated as if fully set forth herein.
