I am writing to provide an update on the FY 2025–27 Preventative Health Grant (PHG) process. All submitted proposals have been reviewed, and the review committee has finalized its funding recommendations. These recommendations will be presented for approval at the March 24 Board Meeting. This year's review process was particularly challenging. We received 50 project and program proposals from 47 nonprofit organizations, totaling \$2,933,817 in funding requests, while only \$674,250 was available. The strength and impact of your work in the community were clearly demonstrated through your submissions. However, due to limited funding, only 25 programs have been recommended for award.

We sincerely appreciate the time, effort, and dedication reflected in each proposal, as well as your continued commitment to serving our community.
