Dear President Varni & Honorable Members of the Oceano Community Services District:

As the Regional State/Government Liaison Officer for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region IV, I am reaching out to inform you of some activities the NRC will be performing in the coming weeks related to the **Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP) License Renewal Application review**.

As will be announced in a *Federal Register* Notice to be published tomorrow (January 24, 2024 – [preview link](#)), the NRC is informing the public of the NRC's intention to conduct environmental scoping and prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) related to the license renewal application for DCPP and providing the public an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process.

The NRC is seeking public comment on this action, and as part of the environmental scoping process, the NRC has scheduled both an **in-person public scoping meeting and a virtual public scoping meeting**.

Public Meetings

The NRC will conduct **two separate scoping process meetings** to gather information necessary to prepare the EIS for this proposed licensing action.

The public scoping meetings will include: (1) an overview by the NRC of the environmental and safety review processes, the proposed scope of the supplement to the generic EIS, and the proposed review schedule; and

(2) the opportunity for interested government agencies, organizations, and individuals to submit comments or suggestions on environmental issues or the proposed scope of the plant-specific supplement to the generic EIS.

A court reporter will transcribe all comments received during the public scoping meetings. To be considered, comments related to the EIS scoping must be provided either at a transcribed public meeting or in writing. Participation in the scoping process by the public and local, State, Tribal, and Federal government agencies is highly encouraged.

Details on how to submit written comments for consideration in scoping may be found in the Federal Register Notice (preview version [HERE](#)), or via the Federal rulemaking website (<https://regulations.gov>) under Docket ID **NRC-2023-0192**. Comments on scoping for the EIS will be accepted for 30 days after the notice is published in the Federal Register (i.e., accepted through February 23, 2024).

Government-to-Government Meeting



In addition to the public meeting on the evening of February 8th, the **NRC will conduct an in-person, government-to-government meeting with local, state, and federal officials, or their representatives, in a non-publicly observed setting.** We are offering this meeting as an additional opportunity for such officials understand the environmental scoping process to be discussed at the public meeting later that evening and to ask questions of the NRC officials. PG&E will not attend this government-to-government meeting.

This in-person only, government-to-government meeting is currently scheduled to occur from 1:00 – 2:00 PM Pacific Time on the same day (February 8, 2024). This government-to-government meeting will also be held at the **Embassy Suites Hotel, 333 Madonna Road, San Luis Obispo, CA.**

Recognizing state/local open-government laws likely apply to your jurisdiction for this non-public meeting, if one or two elected members of your jurisdiction or their representatives would like to attend this government-to-government meeting, you/they would be welcomed. **Please provide me the names and e-mail addresses of any planned attendees for the afternoon government-to-government meeting by Tuesday, February 6, 2024, so that we may plan for seating accordingly.**
